Primary Responsibilities

- Create SQL programs to support business users working on a large scope of projects, including analysis of healthcare cost and utilization patterns, provider demographics and clinical practice patterns, population health initiatives, and operational implementations.
- Ensure the quality of reporting through thoughtful exploration of the data and testing to ensure the integrity of results
- Work closely with business users to review requirements; iteratively develop, recommend and discuss technical designs that will meet requirements and at the same time advance capability
- Coordinate with Fulcrum’s enterprise architect to develop new enterprise data warehouse tables and views that support business intelligence reporting and dashboards
- Create new business intelligence reports and dashboards
- Collaborate with Fulcrum’s Security Officer to create technical procedures and processes that will ensure the security of application interfaces and user access
- Back up the IT support technician by helping business users with technical issues
- Create data dictionaries, reference data, entity relationship diagrams, data flow diagrams, and other information to support business users
